


LITTLE LAKE THEATER SEATING CHART



This is the seating chart used by the box office. We are a theater-in-the-round. That means the audience sits all around and the actors mostly perform from the center stage area, and enter and exit from the aisles. There are some unique things to note about our space:

- When you first arrive at the theater, you will park and walk into an outer hallway behind the D side. Once you have your ticket,

ushers standing in the main entrance (see the arrow on the chart) will show you to your seat.

-There are 3 tiered levels. The seats in green are floor level with "stadium style" flip down seats. Sometimes they squeak a bit when flipping them down! The other levels have a small step up with table and chairs seating.

-The bathrooms, box office, and "quiet space" are located outside of the theater in the direction behind area C. The best aisles to exit are the main aisle with the arrow, lake side, and booth side. Be careful of tripping hazards and actors when using the aisles, even though the house lights will be up. There will be signs directing you the way out to bathrooms and quiet space.

-Unless there is an emergency, avoid road side exit if possible. Even with house lights up, it can't be as well-lit and there are more tripping hazards due to props and set storage backstage.

-For actor safety, the only off-limits area is the stage wall and the stage space within the wall. Before and after the show audience members will have an opportunity to explore the area more fully with Sara as a guide.

-If anyone in your party uses a wheelchair or other mobility assistance devices, please let the box office know when making your reservation. You will have a space for your wheelchair at floor level with members of your party in the stadium seats surrounding. We have a new accessible bathroom as well.
